The Binding of Satan

“In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, ‘Repent, for **the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**’”




The Release of Satan

“The word of the LORD came to me: ‘Son of man, set your face toward **Gog, of the land of Magog**... You will come from your place out of the uttermost parts of the north, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, **a great host, a mighty army**. You will come up against My people Israel, like a cloud covering the land. **In the latter days I will bring you against my land**, that the nations may know Me, when through you, O Gog, I vindicate my holiness before their eyes... **I will rain upon him and his hordes** and the many peoples who are with him **torrential rains and hailstones, fire and sulfur**.... You shall fall on the mountains of Israel, you and all your hordes and the peoples who are with you. I will give you to **birds of prey** of every sort and to the beasts of the field to be devoured.’”

“...and I will say to Not My People, ‘You are My people’; and he shall say, ‘You are my God.’”






